In 2023, WDGY, "The Original Rock N Roll Station", will celebrate its "centennial anniversary", marking 100 years of broadcasting. Founded in 1923 by Dr. George Young, an optometrist who dabbled in radio as a hobby, WDGY was one of the first commercial radio stations in the Twin Cities area. After many genre changes over the years, the legendary WDGY call letters were brought back in 2008 as the station reintroduced its popular '60s and '70s music format; a format which it continues to play today.

WDGY, remains a local and independently owned radio station, operated currently by the third generation of the Borgen family. Brooke, Danielle, and Brent carry on the energy and excitement of WDGY from their father, Greg, who passed away in 2020 and their grandfather Obed who started in the radio business in 1955. Valley Agencies and First State Bank and Trust are proud to be a longtime partner with WDGY and congratulate the Borgen family on 100 years.
